

What does the result mean?

GREEN – result is within normal range for the gent’s age. Depending on where in the range (below), they will be advised to have a repeat test in 1, 2 or 3 years.

AMBER – Just above the maximum GREEN limit (below). recommended, to contact their Doctor for a follow-up test.

RED – “This result is abnormal and outside the guideline range below for a man of your age. It does not necessarily imply there is anything seriously wrong with your prostate but you are strongly advised to see your doctor to repeat your PSA, examine you and, if necessary, refer you to a specialist urologist possibly under the 2 week wait criterion, especially if the repeated PSA result remains above the limit for your age.”
